Council Receives Comprehensive Annual Financial Report; Approves Contract for Municipal Facility Security Enhancements

At the April 13 meeting, City Council approved a contract with WEIL Construction, Inc. for security upgrades to the four main City buildings. In January 2020 Council received a Physical Security Assessment Report from City staff and Kirkpatrick Architectural Studio relating to municipal building security. The report outlined the situation, risk assessment methodology, municipal facilities and recommendations. The goal with the security upgrades is to provide an acceptable level of public access while protecting personnel, equipment, data and other assets from harm, damage or loss. The project consists of updating the access control system, architectural security upgrades and mechanical upgrades at the Municipal Complex, Municipal Service Center, Fire Station and Police Department. WEIL Construction, Inc. provided the lowest responsible bid at \$454,384.

Council received the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) for fiscal year 2020. The report represents the yearly audit of city finances and records. The auditors Pattillo, Brown & Hill, L.L.P. assigned an unqualified opinion of the city's financial statements, which declare the statements present fairly the financial position of the city. During the City Manager's Report, Fire Chief Mike Thomson provided a COVID-19 update. The Department cancelled the scheduled vaccination clinics due to the FDA recommendations to suspend the Johnson & Johnson Janssen vaccine. The Department will wait for further instruction and information from the CDC and FDA.
