Council Approves First Read of Amendments to the Development Regulations at The Bowery

At the April 12 meeting, Council held a public hearing and approved the first read of an ordinance amending the development regulations at Bowery Park (formerly The District). The amendment relates to wall and window signage, adding an additional multi-tenant monument sign, relocation of two (2) dumpsters, utilizing the Building VII site for additional parking until time that Building VII would be constructed, and giving the property owner the option to finish out the Live/Work units in Building II to become residential without the required office space. The second read of the ordinance will be considered at the April 26 meeting.

During the Mayor and Council comments a proclamation was issued recognizing Bella Orona as Mayor for the Day. Ms. Orona, fifth grader at Heritage Elementary School, assisted Mayor Wilcox throughout the meeting.

During the early work session Council received a presentation and discussed fees and updates to the Animal Control ordinance. Further discussion will take place at a future Council meeting.
