Council Appoints Members to Boards and Commissions

At the September 26 meeting, Council approved the professional services agreement with Halff Inc. in the amount of \$178,500 for the landscape architecture, engineering and bidding for the design and construction of projects at Unity Park, Brazos Park and the Highland Village Tennis Center. In December 2021, Council approved the issuance of Certificates of Obligation to fund \$6.41M in park improvement projects. The projects in the agreement with Halff, Inc. include LED lighting upgrades and Musco Controls at the Highland Village Tennis Center and at Unity Park a lighted basketball court, improvements to the flex and baseball fields, and improvements to the athletic field at Brazos Park.

Council appointed members to the City's Board of Ethics, Highland Village Community Development Corporation, Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, Planning and Zoning Commission, and the Zoning Board of Adjustment. The appointments are made on an annual basis and the members will serve two-year terms.

During the Mayor and Council comments, Mayor Jaworski recognized Highland Village resident Luke Westcott for his courage and bravery for intervening when he saw an older student bullying two girls. His actions kept the incident from escalating and showed tremendous courage and maturity. Mayor Jaworski also recognized "Say No to Bullying Week" which will take place October 9-16.
